

# FIJI HEART STUDY



## PURPOSE

- The Fiji Heart Study is the first-ever genetic study of premature coronary events (such as heart attacks or angina/chest pain) for Peoples of Fiji.
- Better representation in research will improve screening, treatment, and heart health outcomes for our future generations.

## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Anyone with Fijian (i-Taukei) or Fijian Indian (Girmit/Indentured) ancestry
- and who has experienced their first heart attack or had related surgery (such as stent or bypass), before reaching 55 years of age
- and is a NZ Permanent Resident or Citizen.
